HISTORY OF PAN

THE PAN TRINBAGO STORY

The Steelband Association virtually began in March of 1950 when eight Steelbands met in East Dry River at the Quarry, in order to discuss putting an end to all hostilities. The Steelbands were Hill 60, Invaders, Casablanca, Destination Tokyo, Crusaders, Merrymakers, All Stars and Desperadoes. Later on in 1950, a Steelband Association was formed.

The Officers were: Sydney Gollop of Crusaders President
Nathaniel Critchlow of City Syncopators Vice President
Sonny Harewood of Crusaders Secretary
George Goddard of Invaders Assistant Secretary
Carlton Biddle of Rising Sun Treasurer.

Later that year a South Branch of the Steelband Association was formed.

One of the major achievements of the newly formed Association was the decision to have Trinidad and Tobago represented by a Steelband at the Festival of Britain.

The first National Steelband was then formed and comprised Orman Patsy Haynes of Casablanca, Elliot Mannette of Invaders, A. Belgrave of Southern Symphony, Anthony Williams of North Stars, Granville Sealey of Tripoli, Philmore Davidson of City Syncopators, Sterling Betancourt of Cross Fire, Andrew de la Bastide of Chicago, Dudley Smith of Rising Sun, Winston Spree Simon of Fascinators/Tokyo, and Theo Stephens of Southern Symphony.

The Steelband Association continued with elections being held every year. It was in 1964 that a new Constitution was introduced and the name of the Association became the National Association of Trinidad and Tobago Steelbandsmen.

The National Association of Trinidad and Tobago Steelbandsmen continued its representation of Steelbandsmen up till 1970, when with the Civil disturbance caused by the Black Power Riots and the resignation of George Goddard and some of the Executive Officers, caused the National Association of Trinidad and Tobago Steelbandsmen to cease to function fully.

For sometime, the Trustee, Melville Bryan carried on in order to preserve the status of the Organisation.

During that period the Steelband Improvement Committee was formed and functioned as an interim body of representation. The Steelband Improvement Committee, led at the time by Roy Augustus, an immediate past Executive Officer of NATTS, encouraged the participation of the Steelbands who were members of the floundering NATTS.

In 1972, the Steelband Improvement Committee formalised its operations and began its function of PAN TRINBAGO.

In 1986, by an Act of Parliament, the Steelband Association became PAN TRINBAGO INC.
